True Fear: Forsaken Souls Part 1 was my favourite point and click game of all time, so I had high expectations for Part 2. The expectations were definitely met since Part 2 is another great game in the series.

Pros: the atmosphere is even better than Part 1's atmosphere since part 2 is set at an asylum. The background music is subtle but adds to the imagery. The story itself is interesting and was continued well from season 1, and it leaves you wanting more because there are still some unsolved mysteries (Part 3 has been confirmed so I expect they'll be answered there).

Cons: I can't think of any cons that aren't bugs/errors. There are a few bugs that could probably be fixed pretty easily with a few patches, for example a few visual glitches with a puzzle - the glitches aren't major enough to affect gameplay, but fixing them would make the game even better. Perhaps the most noticeable errors this game has are the grammatical errors, which are kind of frequent - I would say there are 1 or 2 grammatical errors every few documents you find. Even outside of the documents there are a few grammatical errors, for example when you left click to examine a certain item I remember the text at the top saying the letter 's' instead of 'a' (as in the word 'a').

Also, I don't know if it's just Windows 10 or something about my PC, but sometimes the cutscenes are either completely silent or too loud - changing the volume settings does nothing. During the final cutscene the audio was completely silent even after restarting. I had to watch it on YouTube. That was the only cutscene which was silent. The others were either too loud or just normal. I had the same problem with Part 1.

Suggestions:

- make a few patches fixing the grammatical errors and the small visual bugs with puzzles/gameplay.

Overall rating: 8.85/10 (would probably be moved up to 9 if all the things were fixed).. While some of the fans are disappointed with how non-horror the second part is, this game thrills and puzzles the minds of billions of True Fear fans around the globe. Yes, I have to say that it's the longest and the most complex (not to say perplex) game I have ever played. It is imbued with as much story as controversy.

I am not talking about notoriety, I am talking about perplexity in the sense that this game strikes you from the moment you first see a tool box under a disrepaired bridge, from the moment you hear a gun shot in the air, from the moment you see a red shawl flying above your head to the moment you realize that the exact same tool box, the same gun, shawl or any item you possess in your inventory are the same things that you have witnessed in the beginning of the game while being used by somebody that is a few hours ahead of you. And you know what. Exactly. It's actually YOU.

No, I'm not wrong. You read that correctly. This game, apart from its predecessor, deals with time paradoxes, time shifting, time controversy, even shape shifting, perplexing timing, puzzling history (an asylum history to be precise), and everything that blows up your mind. There are a few scares here or there; however, the main thing is that this game twitches your mind. I don't know if this was meant by Dimmie himself or by the other developers, but this game is awesome!

I recommended it, although, some of the fans are unhappy the way it turned out. Don't let their experience ruin your expectations. If you'll be attentive enough, you might come up with your own theory which I am willing to hear.

Moving back to this review, True Fear: Forsaken Souls Part 2 is as magnificent as its predecessor because of its outstanding graphics, storyline and puzzles. This game has also a hidden timer! During the first half an hour within the game, the sun will eventually set, leaving you stranded in the Administration building all alone in the dark.

About the music. The developers promised to fix the music during this month of November while releasing the Mac and iOS version altogether with the French and German translations.

Unlike its predecessor, the game's Bonus Chapter is in the making. However, the fans are excited with the uploaded images that the developers is gladly sharing with their fans on Facebook. I hope to play it as soon as possible and I wish the devs all the best!

This game has been nominated for "The Best Alternate History" Award on Steam.. For the most part this game was very enjoyable and engaging. It was a nice long HO that you could sink your teeth into. I found some of the mini games bugged along with achievements. I Would win a mini game but it wouldn't register. I'd have to click out and in a few times. Sometimes I'd have to skip it even though I was right to get past it. Also sometimes things just wouldn't progress. I'd finish what was needed but have to re-enter the room or something to trigger events. I also missed out on some achievements such as not skipping the cutscenes (which I didn't) and not skipping the audio tapes (which i didnt) despite achieving them. In the end... the game just sort of... ends? I guess it's meant to be a cliff hanger for a part 3 but it just kinda abruptly ends and feels unfinished... even if it's intended to be a cliff hanger. It's fun enough, just be prepared to be annoyed when it randomly ends.. Well worth the wait! This is the second part of a trilogy that has been long awaited. It delivers on suspense, mystery and the occasional fright. Have played this game (just like I did part 1) over and over and just about to begin again. Love it! Can't wait for part three. I would recommend this game but would start with Part 1, it really is worth it :-). I played the first game some days ago and went to see if there was a part two, happily, there was one.

I loved that game better than the first one but the ending really is a turn off lmao and also I didn't had any sound throughout the whole game when my volume was at 100%. The TrueFear, Part 1 was one of the best adventure games made in history.

It took Goblinz 5 desperate years to produce the second version that was constantly delayed, and in the end experience was ruined.

I cannot tell what I liked about this game. Everything seemed to be bad quality from graphics to music ending in cut scenes. The plot was not obvious, the game story was very engaging in part one, the second part simply fell apart. This is a perfect case of how business logic behind a potentially A+ game took it down.

I will outline a few key factors that made this game a solid NO GO:

1. Lack of money to produce the game (Hello Kickstarter)
2. The game plot has been written while the development was already in progress
3. Bad quality.

- Objects are very pixel sensitive (i.e. you have to be pixel precise to pickup an object from your inventory)

- Bad quality music, clunky, no nice transitions when you move from room to room
 - Lack of scary animations (Hello Part 1)
 - Lame, sometimes very annoying plot that does not keep you engaged
 - Minigames do not have the "restart" options
 - Game crashes all the time
 - Cursor does not change
 - Getting to read emails in the computer is very buggy, hint button does nothing, diary is not functioning.
 - Why inserting real 3D scenes (may be three) into a 2D game?
 - Hint button is cumbersome when moving between the screens

4. No bonus game

5. The journal is a simply copy/paste from "Mystery Case Files: Dire Grove"

6. Half of the things in the home screens like backgrounds and music are not functioning.

7. No "true fear" experience. THE GAME IS NOT SCARY. No those well known animations from part 1 that used to keep you super sense

8. The ending. Oh my god. After all, there is no ending at all. The developers just ran out of time. So they ended it with TBC.

However, if you haven't played the first part, you might want to do that before playing the second one, as the story continues right where it left off at the end of part 1.. Well, this review is open to change provided they patch this as there are so many bugs in the later stages of the asylum it's impossible to progress, it should have been clearly stated this is an unfinished product. You would think that after more than Five Years of delays, false starts and promises that if we would just "Stick with them" we would have an actual working product. That being said this has a very strong opening act but goes rapidly down hill once you get through the gates and not just because of the bugs. It would seem that the production crew didn't actually talk to each other as the clues and narative become very inconsistent and solutions are so obscure that you will be hitting the Hint button very often to find out exactly what you are supposed to be doing. The script is badly written in places and completely misleading in others, the progress is slow and boring, key texts that you need just come in blank and on and on. The overall feeling I get with this game is that GOBLINZ just gave up on it and are hoping for the best. We simply deserve better after all our support and waiting. I will keep checking back in the weeks ahead to see what happens.. This was the best game I have played! I thoroughly enjoyed it! Story, graphics, everything was superb! Can't wait for the next installment!. I have been waiting for this for years! Despite the glitches and the lack of conclusion It was worth it beause of the quality of the story and atmosphere. I hope it comes out on bigfish too though, it's a better platform for it and they haven't had any good horror games for ages.
